Presented by Representative PINKHAM of Lamoine; Cosponsored by Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock and Representatives: DUGAY of Cherryfield, GOODWIN of Pembroke, VOLENIK of Brooklin. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources. Public Hearing 02/01/00. Majority (OTP) Accepted 03/07/00. Amended by: HA H-821. Final Disposition: Emergency Enacted, Signed 03/22/00, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 576.
