An Act to Allow Police Assistance in Emergency Situations. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative MURPHY of Berwick; Cosponsored by Senator LAWRENCE of York and Representatives: BUCK of Yarmouth, CAMERON of Rumford, COLWELL of Gardiner, GAGNON of Waterville, LEMONT of Kittery, MATTHEWS of Winslow, MURPHY of Kennebunk, WHEELER of Eliot, Senators: FERGUSON of Oxford, KONTOS of Cumberland, RAND of Cumberland, RUHLIN of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 01/31/00. Amended by: CA H-908. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/10/00, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 654.
