An Act to Create a State-sponsored Voluntary Logger Certification Program. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative McKEE of Wayne; Cosponsored by Senator DOUGLASS of Androscoggin and Representatives: DUGAY of Cherryfield, GILLIS of Danforth, GOODWIN of Pembroke, SAMSON of Jay, TRACY of Rome, TRAHAN of Waldoboro, Senator MILLS of Somerset.
