Presented by Representative QUINT of Portland; Cosponsored by Senator RAND of Cumberland and Representatives: BRENNAN of Portland, DAVIDSON of Brunswick, KANE of Saco, O'NEIL of Saco, THOMPSON of Naples, WILLIAMS of Orono, Senators: CATHCART of Penobscot, O'GARA of Cumberland.
