Governor's Nomination: Howard H. Dana, Jr. of Portland nominated for reappointment as Maine Supreme Judicial Court Associate Justice, and Nancy D. Mills of Cornville nominated for reappointment and Ellen Gorman of Durham nominated for appointment as Maine Superior Court Justices; Rae Ann French of Augusta nominated as Maine District Court Judge (Seventh District), John McElwee of Caribou as Maine District Court Judge (no resident designation) and Patricia Worth of Belfast as Maine District Court Judge (no resident designation); Courtland D. Perry of Augusta nominated as Maine District Court Judge, Active Retired; Rick E. Lawrence of Portland nominated for appointment as Maine Administrative Court Judge.
