An Act to Prohibit Certain Conduct Relating to Elephants. Presented by Representative MUSE of South Portland; Cosponsored by Senator BENNETT of Oxford and Representatives: BLISS of South Portland, GLYNN of South Portland, JONES of Greenville, MARLEY of Portland, McKEE of Wayne, O'NEIL of Saco, QUINT of Portland, Senator RAND of Cumberland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Public Hearing 03/15/01. House: Minority OTP Accepted 03/29/01, Engrossed As Amended 04/03/01. Senate: Majority ONTP Accepted 04/10/01, Adhere to Majority ONTP 05/01/01. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/01/01.
