Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. Public Hearing 02/27/01. House: Indefinitely Postponed 04/04/01. Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 04/10/01. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence 04/10/01.
