An Act to Require State Approval Prior to Introducing Wolves into Maine. Presented by Representative DUNLAP of Old Town; Cosponsored by Senator MARTIN of Aroostook and Representatives: BRYANT of Dixfield, MICHAUD of Fort Kent, MUSE of Fryeburg, PARADIS of Frenchville, PERKINS of Penobscot, SAVAGE of Buxton, TRAHAN of Waldoboro, WHEELER of Eliot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Public Hearing 03/14/01. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/09/01. Amended by: CA H-348. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 05/22/01, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 227.
