Presented by Representative QUINT of Portland; Cosponsored by Senator RAND of Cumberland and Representatives: DUGAY of Cherryfield, DUNLAP of Old Town, ETNIER of Harpswell, MUSE of South Portland, Senator TREAT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources. Public Hearing 03/29/01. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/07/02.
