An Act to Prohibit the Exclusion of Legal Counsel as a Condition of Settlement. Presented by Representative MITCHELL of Vassalboro; Cosponsored by Senator LONGLEY of Waldo and Representatives: BULL of Freeport, LaVERDIERE of Wilton, LEMOINE of Old Orchard Beach, RICHARDSON of Brunswick, SAVAGE of Buxton, WATERHOUSE of Bridgton. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 03/26/01. OTP Accepted 04/30/01. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 05/09/01, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 108.
