Resolve, to Allow Coastal Municipalities to Regulate the Use of Personal Watercraft. Presented by Representative BULL of Freeport; Cosponsored by Senator EDMONDS of Cumberland and Representatives: ETNIER of Harpswell, HONEY of Boothbay, KOFFMAN of Bar Harbor, SULLIVAN of Biddeford, VOLENIK of Brooklin, Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources. Public Hearing 04/03/01. House: Indefinitely Postponed 05/14/01. Senate: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 05/15/01. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence, 05/15/01.
