An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Investigations by the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices. Presented by Representative CANAVAN of Waterville; Cosponsored by Senator BROMLEY of Cumberland and Representatives: CRESSEY of Baldwin, DUDLEY of Portland, HUTTON of Bowdoinham, MORRISON of Baileyville, TUTTLE of Sanford, Senator DAGGETT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 03/30/01. Majority (OTP) Accepted 05/15/01. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 05/22/01, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 237.
