Presented by Representative SMITH of Van Buren; Cosponsored by Senator MARTIN of Aroostook and Representatives: DUDLEY of Portland, HUTTON of Bowdoinham, TARAZEWICH of Waterboro. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 03/28/01. Majority (OTP) Accepted 05/09/01. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 05/29/01, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 306.
