An Act to Promote Outcome-based Forest Policy. (GOVERNOR'S BILL). Presented by Senator NUTTING of Androscoggin; Cosponsored by Senators: KNEELAND of Aroostook, MICHAUD of Penobscot, Representatives: BRUNO of Raymond, CARR of Lincoln, COWGER of Hallowell, FOSTER of Gray, GOOLEY of Farmington. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Public Hearing 04/06/01. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 05/21/01. Amended by: CA S-222. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 05/31/01, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 339.
