An Act to Guarantee Girls Equal Access to Sports Teams. Presented by Representative MICHAEL of Auburn; Cosponsored by Representatives: McGLOCKLIN of Embden, MENDROS of Lewiston, MUSE of South Portland, MUSE of Fryeburg, TWOMEY of Biddeford, WATSON of Farmingdale. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. Public Hearing 04/10/01. House: Insist on Engrossment 06/05/01, Conference Committee 06/05/01. Senate: Adhere to Majority (ONTP) Report 06/07/01. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 06/08/01.
