RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Require a 2/3 Vote for the Maine Government Facilities Authority to Issue Securities. (Approved for introduction by a Majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative WATERHOUSE of Bridgton; Cosponsored by Senator LEMONT of York and Representatives: KASPRZAK of Newport, McKENNEY of Cumberland, O'BRIEN of Augusta, Senator DAVIS of Piscataquis. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 04/25/01. House: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 06/08/01, Adhere to Majority ONTP Report 06/13/01.
