LD 1848 / HP1410

An Act to Prohibit the Separation of a Husband and Wife Placed in State-funded Nursing Facilities. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative FOSTER of Gray; Cosponsored by Senator SMALL of Sagadahoc and Representatives: CARR of Lincoln, GOOLEY of Farmington, HAWES of Standish, JODREY of Bethel, LUNDEEN of Mars Hill, MICHAUD of Fort Kent, PINEAU of Jay. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. Public Hearing 01/10/02. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 01/25/02.
