Presented by Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock; Cosponsored by Representative BERRY of Livermore and Senators: BENNETT of Oxford, MICHAUD of Penobscot, TURNER of Cumberland. Representatives: BRUNO of Raymond, COLWELL of Gardiner, ROSEN of Bucksport, SAXL of Portland, SCHNEIDER of Durham. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.
