An Act to Fund the Maine Biomedical Research Program. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock; Cosponsored by Representative BERRY of Livermore and Senators: BENNETT of Oxford, MICHAUD of Penobscot, TURNER of Cumberland. Representatives: BRUNO of Raymond, COLWELL of Gardiner, ROSEN of Bucksport, SAXL of Portland, SCHNEIDER of Durham. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 01/07/02. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/25/02.
