LD 1957 / HP1460

An Act to Allow the State to Maximize Funds for Meals for the Elderly in the State. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative SAXL of Portland; Cosponsored by Senator MICHAUD of Penobscot and Representatives: BLISS of South Portland, DORR of Camden, DUDLEY of Portland, ETNIER of Harpswell, HAWES of Standish, MAYO of Bath, NORTON of Bangor, Senator TREAT of Kennebec. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 01/08/02. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 01/25/02.
