LD 1968 / HP1467

An Act to Require the Owner of a Submerged Snowmobile or Boat to Remove the Snowmobile or Boat. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative CLOUGH of Scarborough; Cosponsored by Senator MICHAUD of Penobscot and Representatives: BOWLES of Sanford, CHICK of Lebanon, COLWELL of Gardiner, DUNLAP of Old Town, HATCH of Skowhegan, LaVERDIERE of Wilton, NORBERT of Portland, PERKINS of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Public Hearing 01/16/02. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 03/04/02. Amended by: CA H-844. Final Disposition: Emergency Enacted, Signed 03/18/02, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 536.
