LD 1971 / HP1470

An Act to Support Businesses Engaged in Both Off-premises and On-premises Retail Sales of Malt Liquor and Wine. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative SIMPSON of Auburn; Cosponsored by Senator DOUGLASS of Androscoggin and Representatives: CANAVAN of Waterville, COLWELL of Gardiner, DORR of Camden, HALL of Bristol, McLAUGHLIN of Cape Elizabeth, MICHAUD of Fort Kent, MITCHELL of Vassalboro, NORBERT of Portland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 01/24/02. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/28/02.
