LD 1980 / HP1479

An Act to Extend the Period During Which the Passamaquoddy Tribe May Acquire Land in the City of Calais. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative MORRISON of Baileyville; Cosponsored by Senator YOUNGBLOOD of Penobscot and Representatives: GOODWIN of Pembroke, ANNIS of Dover-Foxcroft, LABRECQUE of Gorham, SOCTOMAH of the Passamaquoddy Tribe, Senator SMALL of Sagadahoc. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 01/23/02. OTP Accepted 02/13/02. Enacted 02/20/02. Vetoed by Governor 03/05/02. Final Disposition: Veto Sustained 03/06/02.
