Original Title: An Act Regarding the Administration of Epinephrine by Emergency Medical Personnel. New Title: Resolve, Directing the Department of Public Safety, Maine Emergency Medical Services, Medical Direction and Practices Board to Review and Update Protocols for Training Basic Emergency Medical Technicians to Administer Epinephrine. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.)
