Resolve, Authorizing Michelle Booker to Sue the State. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative PERRY of Bangor; Cosponsored by Senator SAWYER of Penobscot and Representatives: BLANCHETTE of Bangor, BROOKS of Winterport, LABRECQUE of Gorham, MAYO of Bath, NORTON of Bangor, Senators: BROMLEY of Cumberland, MICHAUD of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 03/19/02. OTP-AM Accepted 04/01/02. Amended by: CA H-1044. Finally Passed 04/09/02. Vetoed by Governor 04/11/02. Final Disposition: Veto Sustained 04/24/02.
