An Act to Ensure Consistent Regulation of Air Emissions in the State. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.)

Presented by Representative DAIGLE of Arundel; Cosponsored by Senator PENDLETON of Cumberland and Senators: MARTIN of Aroostook, SAWYER of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources. Public Hearing 03/21/02. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 04/02/02.
