(Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative CARR of Lincoln; Cosponsored by Senator SHOREY of Washington and Representatives: BUNKER of Kossuth Township, COLLINS of Wells, DUGAY of Cherryfield, JONES of Greenville, McKENNEY of Cumberland, SHERMAN of Hodgdon, Senator DAVIS of Piscataquis. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Business and Economic Development. Public Hearing 03/25/02. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 04/02/02. Amended by: CA H-1035, SD/CA S-605.
