Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. Public Hearing 03/14/03. House: Engrossment Failed 04/14/03. Senate: Indefinitely Postponed 04/15/03. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 04/15/03.
