An Act to Consolidate the Advocacies of the Various State Agencies into an Executive Department and Establish the Office of Inspector General. Presented by Representative BUNKER of Kossuth Township; Cosponsored by Senator DAGGETT of Kennebec and Representatives: COLWELL of Gardiner, DUPLESSIE of Westbrook, JOY of Crystal, RICHARDSON of Brunswick, Senators: DAVIS of Piscataquis, WOODCOCK of Franklin. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 03/18/03. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 01/28/04.
