LD 1776 / HP1298

An Act To Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$150,000,000 To Finance the Acquisition of Land and Interest in Land for Conservation, Water Access, Outdoor Recreation, Wildlife and Fish Habitat and Farmland Preservation and To Access \$50,000,000 in Matching Contributions from Public and Private Sources. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative RICHARDSON of Brunswick; Cosponsored by Senator TREAT of Kennebec and Representatives: PINGREE of North Haven, COLWELL of Gardiner, DUPLESSIE of Westbrook, McKEE of Wayne, McNEIL of Rockland, SMITH of Monmouth, WATSON of Bath, Senators: SAWYER of Penobscot, MARTIN of Aroostook, TURNER of Cumberland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 03/03/04. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 04/28/04.
