An Act To Authorize the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife To Increase the Number of Moose Permits in High-accident Areas. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative PARADIS of Frenchville; Cosponsored by Senator BRYANT of Oxford and Representatives: COLLINS of Wells, DUDLEY of Portland, DUNLAP of Old Town, HATCH of Skowhegan, LESSARD of Topsham, PATRICK of Rumford, WOTTON of Littleton, Senator HATCH of Somerset.
