Presented by Representative WOODBURY of Yarmouth; Cosponsored by Senator TURNER of Cumberland and Representatives: DUDLEY of Portland, MAILHOT of Lewiston, MILLETT of Waterford, PINGREE of North Haven, ROSEN of Bucksport, Senators: BRENNAN of Cumberland, DOUGLASS of Androscoggin, ROTUNDO of Androscoggin.
