An Act To Require Surety Bonding by Payroll Processing Companies. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative DUNLAP of Old Town; Cosponsored by Senator HALL of Lincoln and Representatives: BENNETT of Caribou, BREault of Buxton, FINCH of Fairfield, GROSE of Woolwich, MOODY of Manchester, PERRY of Calais, THOMPSON of China, WOTTON of Littleton, Senator TREAT of Kennebec.
