Resolve, To Provide for the Reorganization of the Student Loan Repayment and Forgiveness Programs To Better Meet the Needs of Maine Employers and the Maine Economy. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative FISCHER of Presque Isle; Cosponsored by Senator DOUGLASS of Androscoggin and Representatives: CUMMINGS of Portland, MILLS of Cornville, MURPHY of Kennebunk, SULLIVAN of Biddeford, THOMAS of Orono, Senators: CATHCART of Penobscot, HALL of Lincoln, MITCHELL of Penobscot.
