LD 1878 / HP1395

An Act To Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$65,000,000 To Finance the Acquisition of Land and Interest in Land for Conservation, Water Access, Outdoor Recreation, Wildlife and Fish Habitat and Farmland Preservation; To Fund Capital Improvements to State Parks and Other Historic Public Areas; and To Access \$30,250,000 in Matching Contributions from Public and Private Sources. (GOVERNOR'S BILL). Presented by Representative RICHARDSON of Brunswick; Cosponsored by Senator TREAT of Kennebec and Representatives: COLWELL of Gardiner, DUPLESSIE of Westbrook, McKEE of Wayne, PINGREE of North Haven, SMITH of Monmouth, WATSON of Bath, Senators: SAWYER of Penobscot, TURNER of Cumberland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 03/03/04. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 04/28/04.
