An Act To Prohibit Financial Institutions from Requiring a Fingerprint or Thumbprint To Complete a Transaction. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative TWOMEY of Biddeford; Cosponsored by Representatives: CANAVAN of Waterville, COLLINS of Wells, EDER of Portland, McKEE of Wayne, O'BRIEN of Lewiston, PARADIS of Frenchville, SAVIELLO of Wilton. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Insurance and Financial Services. Public Hearing 03/17/04. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 03/29/04.
