An Act To Prohibit a Registered Sex Offender from Residing within 1,000 Feet of the Residence of Any Child, a School, Day Care Center or Playground. Presented by Representative BERUBE of Lisbon; Cosponsored by Senator COURTNEY of York and Representatives: DAVIS of Augusta, WALCOTT of Lewiston, VAUGHAN of Durham, Senators: MITCHELL of Kennebec, NUTTING of Androscoggin. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. Public Hearing 02/07/05. House: Majority (ONTP) Report 05/24/05, Insist on Majority (ONTP) Report 05/31/05. Senate: Minority (OTP-AM) Report 05/25/05, Engrossed 05/26/05. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/31/05.
