An Act To Require That the Department of Health and Human Services Include a Bureau of Elder Services. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. Public Hearing 04/08/05. OTP Accepted 05/05/05. House: Enacted 05/11/05, Insist on Enactment 06/08/05. Senate: Indefinitely Postponed 06/07/05, Adhere to Indefinite Postponement 06/09/05. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 06/09/05.
