Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor. Public Hearing 04/06/05. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 06/17/05. Amended by: CA H-372, HA/CA H-708. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 06/30/05, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 461.
