Resolve, To Allow the Somerset County Jail To Be Built within One Mile of the County Seat. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Senator MILLS of Somerset; Cosponsored by Senator DAVIS of Piscataquis Representatives: CURTIS of Madison, FINCH of Fairfield, FITTS of Pittsfield, PINEAU of Jay, PINKHAM of Lexington Township, RICHARDSON of Skowhegan, STEDMAN of Hartland, THOMAS of Ripley. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 03/23/05. Final Disposition: Died on Adjournment 06/18/05.
