Presented by Senator MITCHELL of Kennebec; Cosponsored by Representative CANAVAN of Waterville and Senators: GAGNON of Kennebec, PLOWMAN of Penobscot, Representatives: LEWIN of Eliot, MOORE of Standish, NUTTING of Oakland, PATRICK of Rumford, THOMPSON of China. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 05/09/05. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 03/27/06.
