An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Crimes against People Who Are Homeless. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative DUDLEY of Portland; Cosponsored by Senator BRENNAN of Cumberland and Representatives: ADAMS of Portland, CRAVEN of Lewiston, DUNN of Bangor, FAIRCLOTH of Bangor, Senators: EDMONDS of Cumberland, GAGNON of Kennebec, PERRY of Penobscot, ROTUNDO of Androscoggin.
