RESOLUTION, Amending the Constitution of Maine To Lower the Age of Eligibility for Election to the House of Representatives. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative CAIN of Orono; Cosponsored by Representatives: BRYANT of Windham, CUMMINGS of Portland, McFADDEN of Dennysville, PINGREE of North Haven, Senator BARTLETT of Cumberland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Public Hearing 01/27/06. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 03/22/06. Amended by: CA H-809. Final Disposition: Final Passage Failed 05/23/06.
