An Act To Amend the Laws Pertaining to Lobbying. Presented by Representative CANAVAN of Waterville; Cosponsored by Senator EDMONDS of Cumberland and Representatives: CROCKETT of Augusta, PINGREE of North Haven, SAVAGE of Falmouth, TRINWARD of Waterville, Senator DOW of Lincoln. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/17/07.
