An Act To Require the Maine Community College System, the University of Maine System and the Maine Maritime Academy To Report the Number of Students Enrolled in Remedial Courses. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator ALFOND of Cumberland. Referred to Jt. Standing Comm. on Education and Cultural Affairs. Public Hearing 02/07/12. Majority (Ought to Pass as Amended) Accepted 03/28/12. Amended by: CA S-475. Final Disposition: Enacted, Neither Signed nor Vetoed 04/12/12, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 615.
