Resolve, Directing the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management To Request the Federal Government To Recognize Environmental Hazards at the Military Training Center in Gagetown, New Brunswick and the Resulting Health Risks and Disabilities Suffered by Certain Members of the Maine National Guard. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator TUTTLE of York. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Veterans and Legal Affairs. Public Hearing 01/27/14. OTP-AM Accepted 03/18/14. Amended by: CA S-421. Final Disposition: Finally Passed, Signed 04/02/14, RESOLVE, Chapter 100.
