(Submitted by the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Forestry pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 8072 and approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council.) Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Public Hearing 05/19/15. OTP Accepted 05/29/15. Final Disposition: Emergency Finally Passed, Unsigned 06/16/15, RESOLVE, Chapter 26.
