An Act To Allow Maine Residents To Personally Import Medications as Permitted under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative MARTIN of Eagle Lake. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development. Public Hearing 05/27/15. In House: Minority (OTP) Report Accepted, Engrossed; Insisted. In Senate: Majority (ONTP) Report Accepted; Insisted. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 06/18/15.
