Joint Resolution Making Application to the Congress of the United States for Calling a Convention to Propose Amendments to the Constitution of the United States to Limit the Power of the Federal Government. Presented by Representative STANLEY of Medway; Cosponsored by Senator DAVIS of Piscataquis and Representatives: ALLEY of Beals, BICKFORD of Auburn, ESPLING of New Gloucester, HARLOW of Portland, HILLIARD of Belgrade, ORDWAY of Standish, SKOLFIELD of Weld, Senator: MASON of Androscoggin. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted in House; Minority O.T.P. Accepted in Senate. Failed Adoption in Senate. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses, 05/31/17.
