Joint Resolution Making Application to the Congress of the United States Calling a Constitutional Convention under Article V of the United States Constitution Limited to Proposing an Amendment to the United States Constitution to Impose Congressional Term Limits. Presented by Representative WADSWORTH of Hiram; Cosponsored by Representative STANLEY of Medway. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. Majority (ONTP) Report Accepted in House; Minority (OTP) Report Accepted in Senate; Failed Adoption in Senate. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses, 03/22/18.
